We acknowledge receipt of your Privacy Act request. Your request reads:

Personal information request on behalf of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (CBSA Client ID: XX-XXXX-XXXX) and her minor child, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] de [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (CBSA Client ID: XX-XXXX-XXXX), with written authorization of Ms. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (BSF745 and her passport attached). Information requested - both subjects, YUL Montreal-Trudeau International Airport, March 20-22, 2026:

1. All records, notes, reports, memoranda, officer notebooks, and internal communications related to processing, examination, interview, detention, and removal of both subjects, from first contact at primary inspection on March 20, 2026 through departure on March 22, 2026.
2. ALL CCTV and video surveillance recordings - complete, continuous and uninterrupted - from EVERY CBSA-controlled area at YUL where Ms. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] or her minor child were present during the entire period March 20-22, 2026. Without limitation: (a) primary inspection; (b) secondary inspection rooms; (c) interview rooms where Ms. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was questioned and any eligibility/admissibility interview took place; (d) holding/waiting areas; (e) corridors and hallways transited; (f) processing offices where forms were completed or signed; (g) any room where an interpreter was present; (h) any room where IMM 5317, IMM 5480 or IMM 1282 were signed. Complete recordings for ALL hours in CBSA custody/control - not fragments.
3. All GCMS/FOSS/ICES/IOS notes, system entries, flags, lookouts, alerts, and electronic records for both subjects for the above period and any related prior/subsequent processing.
4. All documents signed by, presented to, or prepared on behalf of either subject, including IMM 5317 (withdrawal), IMM 5480 (s.44(1) report), IMM 1282 (Allowed to Leave), any interpreter declaration, and any related forms/waivers.
5. All records related to the separation of the family unit, the s.44(1) inadmissibility determination under s.41(a) IRPA, issuance of removal/departure orders, and any ministerial authorization under s.42(2) IRPR.
6. Records related to the designation (or non-designation) of a designated representative for the minor child under s.167(2) IRPA.
7. Complete travel history (entry AND exit): both subjects entered Canada on March 20, 2026 and were removed on March 21-22, 2026. All API, PNR, and carrier records for those movements.

PRESERVATION: Pursuant to s.6(3) Privacy Act, preserve all responsive records - including ALL CCTV footage for the hours and locations specified - pending resolution of this request and any related legal proceedings.
