Your request pursuant to the Privacy Act was received in our office on April 13, 2026, and reads:

"I request all personal information held by CBSA relating to me, GUTIERREZ VERDUZCO, Victor Manuel (UCI xx-xxxx-xxxx), for April 8, 2026, at the CBSA office located at 1010 Saint-Antoine Ouest, 2nd floor, Montreal. On that date, I attended the CBSA office and had a conversation with an immigration officer in the area in front of the security guard's desk on the 2nd floor. During this interaction, the officer provided me with an original immigration identification document. Specifically, I request: 1. All CCTV, surveillance footage, and audio/video recordings in their entirety from the area in front of the security guard's desk on the 2nd floor of the CBSA office at 1010 Saint-Antoine Ouest, where I interacted with an immigration officer on April 8, 2026, from approximately 13:30 to 15:00 hours. Complete, continuous, uninterrupted recordings from the beginning of the interaction through to my departure. 2. All documents, reports, notes, and communications related to my visit on that date, including any notes or records created by the immigration officer I interacted with. 3. Any other records containing my personal information for this date and location not covered above. DOB: xxxx-xx-xx"

We will require an additional 30 days beyond the initial 30 days specified in the Privacy Act to respond to your request due to high volume of requests currently being processed by our institution. This extension is in accordance with paragraph 15(a)(i) of the Privacy Act. The extension is necessary as meeting the original time limit would unreasonably interfere with the operations of the institution.

The Canada Border Services Agency is committed to assist you with your request and will ensure that every reasonable effort is made to help you receive a complete, accurate and timely response.
